# SCHOOL PROGRAM

# We are enthusiastic about the beautiful lessons that Judaism has to offer, and we hope to transmit that excitement to the children through the excellent Hebrew School program at Chabad.

The Chabad Hebrew School offers an outstanding program that will give your child a solid foundation in the fundamentals of Judaism, and will instill in your child the faith, beauty and values of our heritage.

All lessons will be taught in a manner that will give the children a great appreciation of our rich Jewish heritage. Role-playing, arts & crafts, and songs will be incorporated to help make the lessons enjoyable.

We plan special programs during the year, such as Shabbat experiences, Shofar Factory, Chanukah Rally, Purim Fun, Passover Matzah Baking, Model Seder, Lag B'Omer Community Parade & Picnic, and more.

We believe that the joy and pride in Yiddishkeit that will be experienced at the Chabad Hebrew School will make an indelible impression upon the children.

# **Chabad Hebrew School Curriculum**

Our curriculum consists of the following:

Hebrew Alphabet	Jewish History
Hebrew Reading and Writing	The Jewish Calendar
Hebrew Prayer	Love for Israel
Jewish Laws and Customs	Synagogue Life
Jewish Holidays	Bible - Torah Portions
Jewish Values	Jewish Songs

#### **HEBREW LANGUAGE:**

Children will learn to recognize and identify the names of all Hebrew letters. They will begin reading simple words after learning how to blend the sounds. Additionally, they will begin to learn how to write the letters in the Hebrew script. Hebrew vocabulary is a basic part of the program - Children will learn Hebrew words related to current themes.

#### **MITZVOT:**

Children will be taught the meaning of Mitzvoth - Torah commandments - and will be encouraged to enjoy the experience of doing mitzvoth. Some mitzvoth emphasized are Tzedaka, loving one another, kindness to living creatures, hospitality, honoring parents, mezuzah, and brachot (blessings). The teachers will help each child develop a consciousness of proper Torah behavior towards others - *Midot Tovot* - which is the acquisition of desirable character traits.



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# Chabad Hebrew School Curriculum Cont.

#### VALUES & ETHICS:

Using age-appropriate textbooks students will read and discuss stories and case scenarios that have practical application to our everyday life. They will understand that our religion is based on a G-d given set of values and morals and that the "norm" is not always right. Beginning with the origin of the Mitzvot, our students will explore a personal Jewishness.

#### HOLIDAY OBSERVANCES:

Providing a deeper understanding of Shabbat, we will explore its traditions and customs, and the reasons behind them. Hands-on lessons for each Jewish holiday will fill the calendar as we begin with learning about the High Holidays and continue throughout the entire school year. By the end of the year, the students will have a deeper understanding and appreciation of each holiday, its traditions and customs.

Hand crafted and decorated Menorahs, honey dishes, Seder plates, Shofars, Matzah baking and more will bring our holidays to life and enable the children to bring home a taste of Jewish life.

#### **PRAYER AND BLESSINGS:**

Children will start to learn simple, basic prayers and blessings. As they progress they will learn more prayers and what is appropriate to say at which times.

#### TORAH, JEWISH HISTORY & ISRAEL

The children will be introduced to the characters and stories of the Torah (Bible), learning to view our *Avot* (Patriarchs) and *Imahot* (Matriarchs) and other Jewish heroic figures as role models.

An overview of Jewish history starting with creation to the giving of the Torah to modern day Israel will be taught through interactive stories and art projects.

The students will gain an appreciation for our heritage and culture that has been preserved throughout the ages. They will study the Torah Portions, providing them with practical lessons that apply to our daily lives. They will also attain an affection for the uniqueness of Israel, our homeland.

Chabad Hebrew School will also host holiday & Shabbat celebrations for students and their families.
